

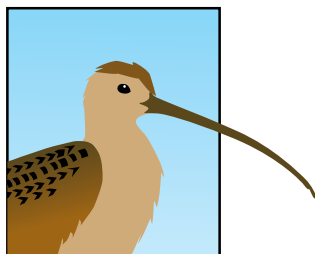
Beaks that help birds eat

Draw a line between each bird and its **prey** (food). Hint: read the clues to help you find the perfect prey for each bird.

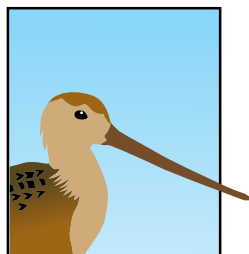
Longbilled curlew

I eat a shelled animal with a curled tail.



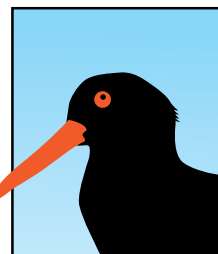
Marbled godwit

I eat a wiggly animal that burrows deep.



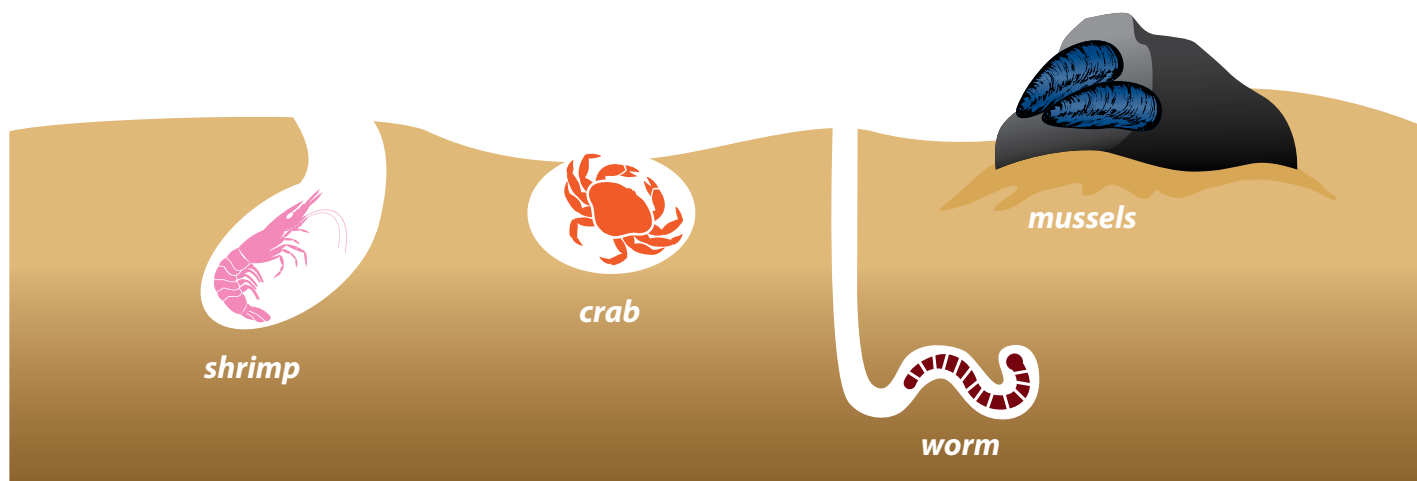
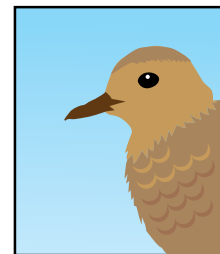
Oystercatcher
