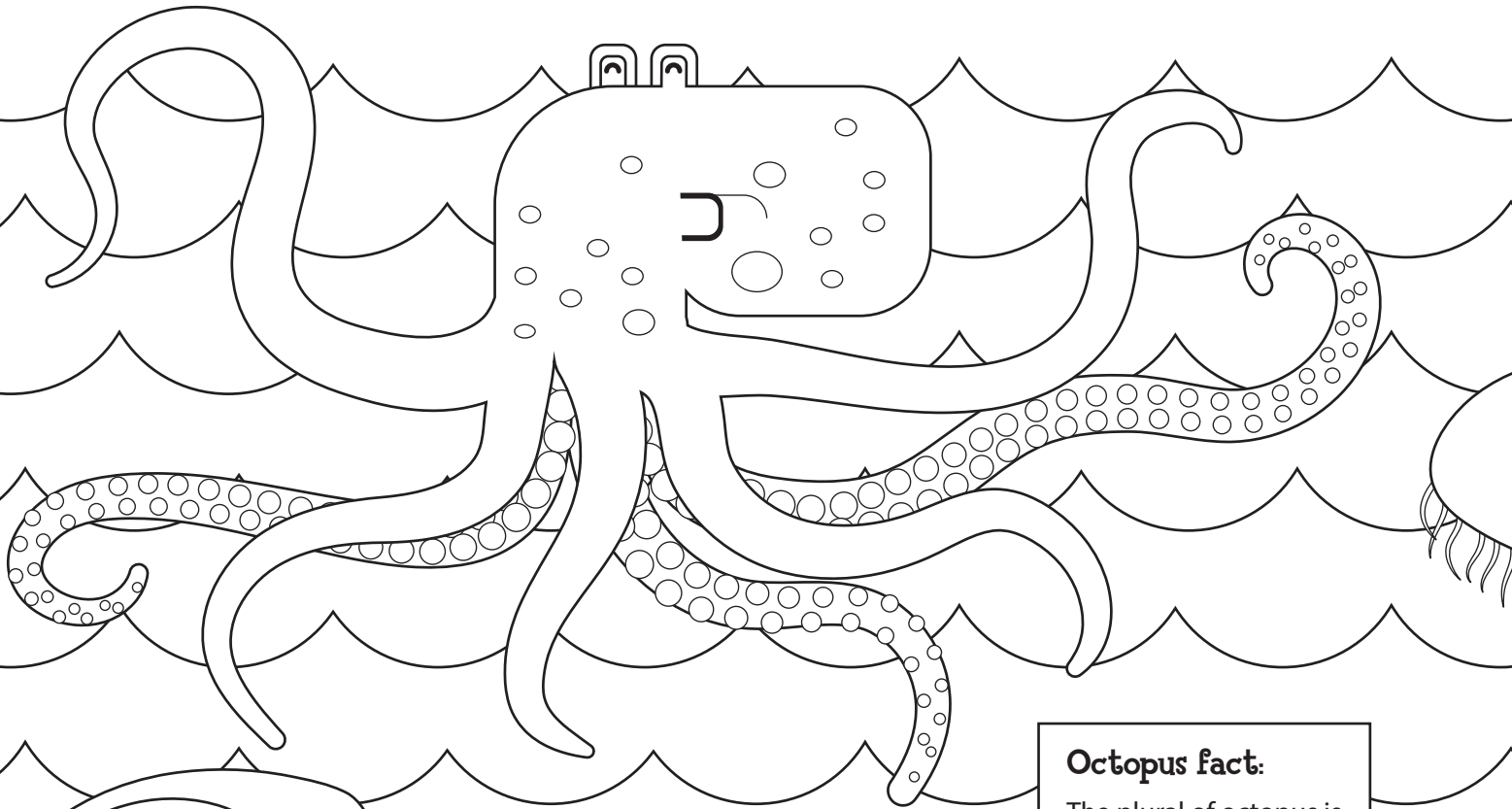
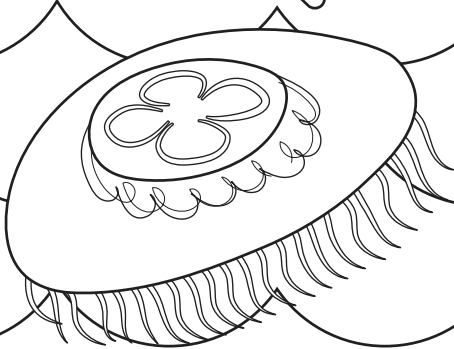

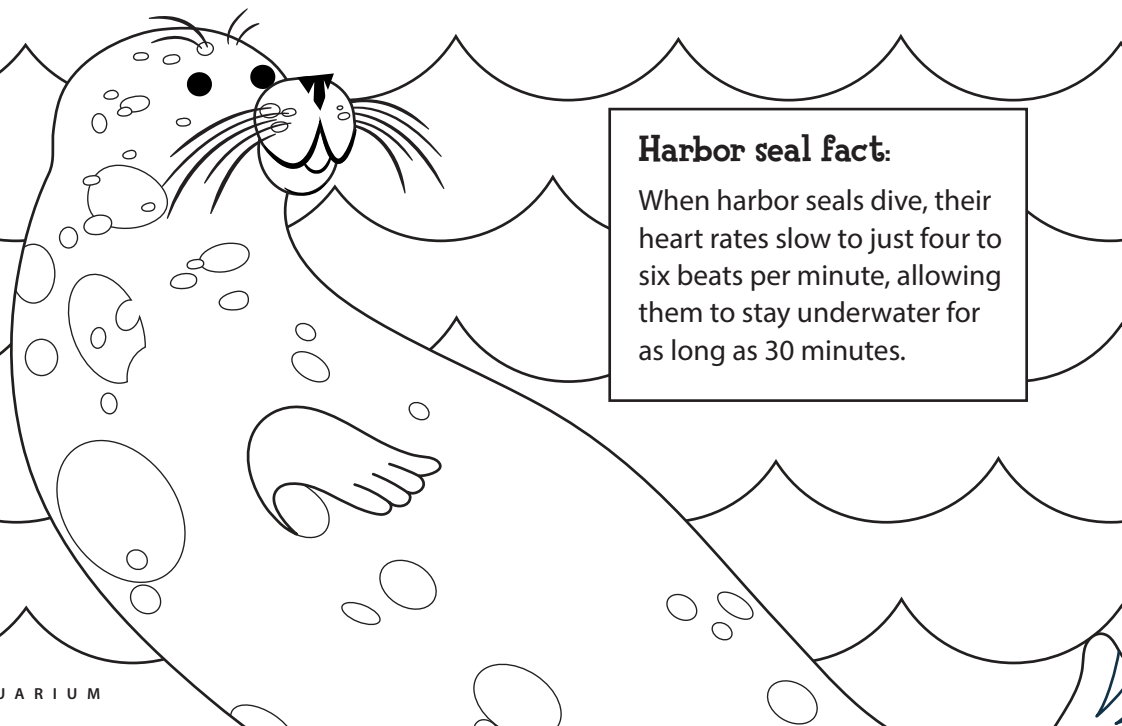
Octopus fact:

Jellyfish have been around for hundreds of millions of years—since before dinosaurs roamed the Earth.



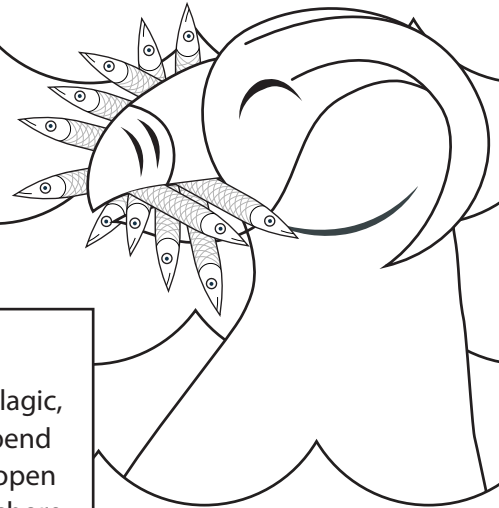
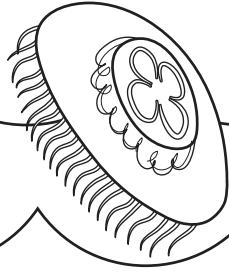
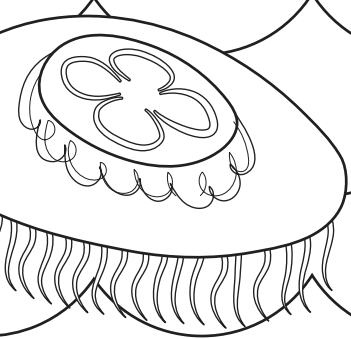
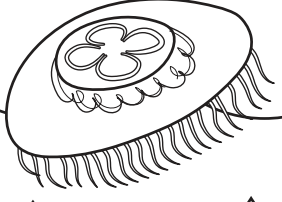
Harbor seal fact:
