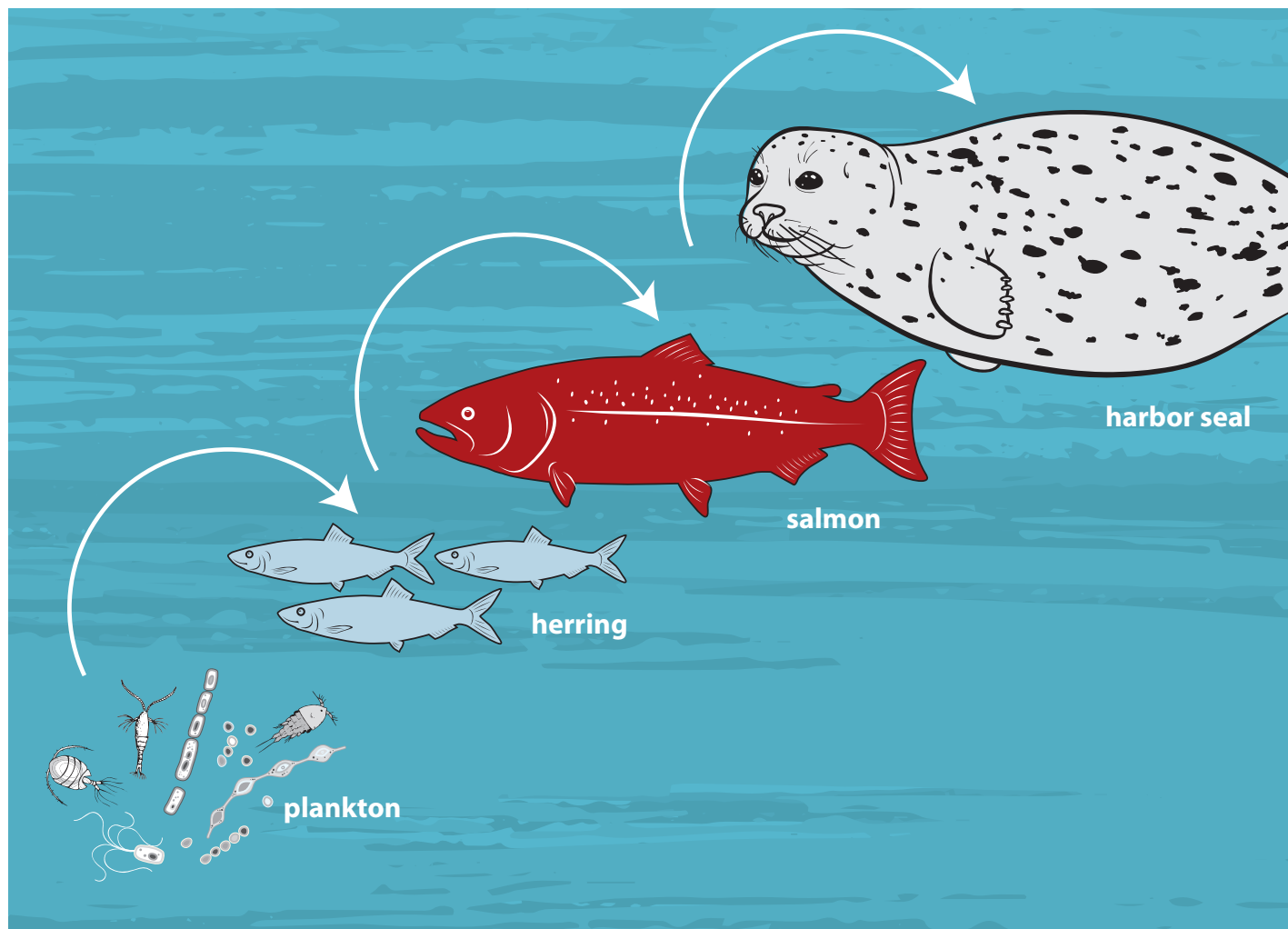


Who eats whom in Puget Sound?

The diagram below is one part of the **food web** showing the feeding relationships between animals that live in Puget Sound and the Salish Sea. Each of these animals, from microscopic plankton to marine mammals like the harbor seal, plays an important role in this ecosystem. It's basically a diagram of who eats whom!

Follow the arrows from the **prey** to the **predator**.
