



Thank you for taking time to be a field trip chaperone to the Seattle Aquarium! Please remember that your priority is student safety. These guidelines are designed to keep your group safe, foster learning and have fun! It is your responsibility to **stay with your student group at all times** while at the Aquarium.

Field trip code:

- O – One gentle finger** when touching animals
- R – Respect other guests**, Aquarium staff/volunteers and the space (no climbing or unsafe behavior)
- C – Caring Cove** is off-limits to school groups
- A – Adults** will stay with their group of students at all times
- S – Snacks and lunches** can only be eaten along the walls of our tide pool habitat

Other field trip tips:

- **Be aware of the students in your care at all times.** Please make sure you always know where they are. It's your responsibility to set an example of what good field trip behavior looks like!
- Eat your snack or lunch along the east mural wall adjacent to the Life on the Edge touch pool habitat in Pier 59, or outside on Pier 59's back deck if the weather permits. Food brought into the Aquarium should not be eaten in any other habitat, the Ocean Pavilion or the café.
- Recycle, compost and/or dispose of your waste in the appropriate bins.
- When exploring, be mindful and respectful of other visitors. Please do not climb on habitats or stand on/jump over benches.
- Individual chaperone groups may register for our paid virtual reality experience, but only with approval from a teacher. Students will not be allowed to participate in VR without direct supervision from their teacher and any other responsible chaperones/caregivers. Guests must be at least 7 years old and 42 inches tall to participate in a VR experience.
- If you are registered for a classroom program, your Aquarium instructor will meet you at the bottom of the green stairs next to the elevator five minutes before your program is scheduled to begin.
- **The blue map and the chaperone sticker provided to you by Aquarium staff on arrival will be your pass to move between the Ocean Pavilion and Piers 59 and 60. Don't lose them!**
